SLC Registration & Uploads

Members competing in these events go directly to the State Leadership Conference. Advisors should register them ahead of the published deadline, and competitors in the starred events should upload their materials by the same deadline.

**Note - Each chapter gets a certain number of entries per event based on the size of their chapter: 5-50 members = 2 entries per event, 51-100 members = 3 entries per event, 101+ members = 4 entries per event*

State Leadership Conference

Members competing in these events will either complete a test, presentation, or skills at the State Leadership Conference (refer to the guidelines for details of each event). The top 3 in each event at SLC qualify to attend the International Leadership Conference in June. 4th and 5th place finishers may also “bump” if one of the top three declines their spot.
