Heat Safety


With all of these extreme heat advisories, its a good idea to remember the importance of heat protection and safety!

PATHS TO BE A DOCTOR AROUND THE WORLD



EUROPEAN UNION

- Go straight to medical school from high school
- Enroll in university for 6 years (free for some of the European Union citizens depending on the country)
- Graduate with an MBBS (MD equivalent)
- Have at least 6 months of supervised training to practice independently Specialty training is another 3-6 years
 - of study and job training supervised by a registered specialized physician

ASIA

- Go straight to medical school from high school
- Enroll in university for 5-6 years
- Graduate with an MBBS (MD equivalent)
- Some countries, like India, require a year internship out of medical school
- Complete a 3-6 year residency (length depends on the specialty)





AUSTRALIA

- Go straight to medical school from high school
- Enroll in university for 5-6 years •
- Must complete 1 year of an internship
- Graduate with an MBBS (MD) equivalent)
- Complete a 1-2 year residency
- Specialty training is another 3-7 years of study and job training supervised by a registered specialized physician

SOUTH AMERICA + AFRICA

- Go straight to medical school complete a 3-5 year residency (length from high school
- enroll in university for 6-7 years
- graduate with an MBBS (MD equivalent)
- depends on the specialty)
